Ravinia Train Station Re-Roofing & Painting

Good morning,

Union Pacific / Metra has hired a contractor to have the Ravinia train station re-roofed and the exterior of the building painted. Public notification signs were posted at the station by Metra on 4/5/2016. The project was initiated on 4/11/2016 and is expected to be completed by 6/24/2016. The contractor they have hired to complete the work is L. Marshall Roofing and Sheet Metal, Inc., from Glenview Illinois.

The Metra Train Station building will be closed during this project.

There is a portable toilet on site for public use during the project, located just off the parking lot by the Kiosk which was there yesterday when the project began.

There is a perimeter fence placed 8 feet around the entire building, and the area is clearly marked.

The current exterior paint contains lead and will be abated as part of this project.

There are 5 parking spaces located on St Johns Ave. directly East of the station. The contractor will occupy these spaces for the duration of the project. One space will have a dumpster during some of the project.
